## **GOALS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE BACHELOR'S DEGREE IN NUTRITION AND FOOD SCIENCE**

### **Goal 1**

To train graduates who affect, from the professional scope, the dietary and nutritional condition of the individuals and groups with which they work.

### **Objectives**

1. 80 % of the students will complete the Bachelor program in no more than 6 years (ideally, in 4 years and 6 months)
2. 70 % of the graduates practice the profession in the area of nutrition and food science within 12 months post-graduation
3. 70 % of the licensed graduates receive their professional license within the first year post-graduation
4. 70 % of the employers are satisfied with the performance of the graduates
5. 30% of the graduates start their graduate studies at 12 months of graduation

## **Goal 2**

Train graduates who are aware of the environment of the individual or groups with which they work, based on humanistic principles.

### **Objectives**

1. 85% of the graduates are satisfied with the social and ethical training they received
2. 80 % of the graduates apply the humanistic principles in their daily professional practice
3. 95 % of the graduates work respecting the diversity of individuals and populations
4. 60% of the graduates promotes socio-environmental sustainability in the professional field
